The show aims to deliver practical advice for young people who are passionate about working in the environmental jobs sector, and to promote the benefits to industry and business of employing young people with sound environmental education backgrounds.

We will be interviewing experts in government departments, environmental groups and industry to get the inside story on how to land that environmental dream job.
